Apelin-13 (human, bovine, mouse, rat) is a 13-amino-acid A peptide from the apelin/APJ system, an endogenous ligand for the APJ receptor (angiotensin receptor-like 1). Apelin signaling regulates cardiovascular function, fluid homeostasis, angiogenesis, and energy metabolism. Used in cardiovascular and metabolic research for studying heart failure, pulmonary hypertension, and diabetes-related vascular dysfunction.
