Gastric mucin is a 16-amino-acid synthetic peptide. A synthetic peptide used as a research tool in biochemistry, pharmacology, and biomedical research. This peptide enables the study of protein-protein interactions, receptor binding, enzyme substrate specificity, and signal transduction pathways. Available in high purity (>=95% by HPLC) as a lyophilized powder for reconstitution in appropriate buffers.
