PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Physalaemin is a 15-amino-acid A peptide related to the tachykinin/substance P family, an 11-amino-acid neuropeptide that signals through NK1 receptors to mediate pain transmission, inflammation, emesis, and neurogenic vasodilation. Widely used in pain, inflammation, and neuroscience research for studying nociception, neurogenic inflammation, and the development of NK1 receptor antagonists (e.g., aprepitant for chemotherapy-induced nausea).
