PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Neurotensin (Frog) is a 17-amino-acid A peptide related to the neurotensin system, a 13-amino-acid neuropeptide that functions as both a neurotransmitter and neuromodulator. Neurotensin signals through NTS1 and NTS2 receptors to modulate dopaminergic transmission, pain perception, thermoregulation, and gastrointestinal motility. Used in neuroscience and oncology research for studying neurotensin receptor signaling, antipsychotic mechanisms, and tumor biology.
