Angiotensin II Receptor, AT2, Amino Terminal Fragment is a 17-amino-acid A peptide related to the renin-angiotensin system (RAS), which plays a critical role in blood pressure regulation, fluid and electrolyte balance, and cardiovascular homeostasis. This peptide is used in cardiovascular and renal research to study angiotensin receptor (AT1R/AT2R) signaling, vasoconstriction/vasodilation pathways, and the development of antihypertensive therapeutics.
