Ranatensin is a 15-amino-acid A peptide related to the bombesin/gastrin-releasing peptide (GRP) family, which mediates diverse physiological functions including gastrointestinal motility, hormone secretion, cell proliferation, and satiety signaling. This peptide is used in oncology and gastrointestinal research to study GRP receptor (GRPR/BB2) signaling, tumor growth, and the development of targeted diagnostic and therapeutic agents.
