Exendin 4 (1-8) is a 10-amino-acid A peptide related to the incretin/glucagon family, involved in glucose homeostasis, insulin secretion, and metabolic regulation. These peptides signal through GLP-1R, GIPR, or glucagon receptors and are central to diabetes and obesity research. Used for studying incretin-based therapeutics, beta-cell function, and metabolic signaling pathways.
