PACAP-38 (28-38) (human, chicken, mouse, ovine, porcine, rat) is a 13-amino-acid A peptide related to the vasoactive intestinal peptide (VIP) / PACAP family, a 28-amino-acid neuropeptide that signals through VPAC1 and VPAC2 receptors. VIP mediates vasodilation, smooth muscle relaxation, exocrine secretion, immune modulation, and circadian rhythm regulation. Used in immunology, neuroscience, and gastrointestinal research.
