[Beta-Asp5] Vasopressin is a 38-amino-acid A peptide related to the vasopressin (antidiuretic hormone, ADH) family, a cyclic nonapeptide that regulates water reabsorption, vascular tone, and social behavior through V1a, V1b, and V2 receptors. Used in renal, cardiovascular, and behavioral neuroscience research for studying fluid balance, vasoconstriction, and the neurochemistry of social cognition.
