Pancreatic Polypeptide (rana temporaria) is a 38-amino-acid A peptide from the neuropeptide Y (NPY) family, one of the most abundant neuropeptides in the brain. NPY signals through Y1-Y5 receptors to regulate appetite, energy balance, anxiety, circadian rhythms, and cardiovascular function. Used in neuroscience, metabolic, and cardiovascular research for studying feeding behavior, stress responses, and sympathetic nervous system regulation.
