ACTH (18-39) (human) (Adrenocorticotrophic Hormone) (Biotin) is a 28-amino-acid A peptide related to the melanocortin system, derived from proopiomelanocortin (POMC) or its analogs. Melanocortins signal through MC1R-MC5R receptors to regulate pigmentation, inflammation, energy homeostasis, and sexual function. Used in dermatology, endocrinology, and neuroscience research for studying melanocortin receptor pharmacology and POMC processing.
