Biotin-Calcitonin (salmon I) is a 61-amino-acid A peptide related to the calcitonin/CGRP superfamily, involved in calcium homeostasis, bone metabolism, vasodilation, and nociception. Used in endocrinology and neuroscience research to study calcitonin receptor (CTR) and CGRP receptor (CLR/RAMP1) signaling, with applications in osteoporosis, migraine, and pain research.
