Somatostatin Tumor Inhibiting Analog/Lanreotide Acetate is a 34-amino-acid A peptide related to the somatostatin family, a cyclic peptide hormone that inhibits the secretion of growth hormone, insulin, glucagon, and other hormones through SSTR1-5 receptors. Somatostatin analogs are clinically used for treating acromegaly and neuroendocrine tumors. Used in endocrinology and oncology research for studying hormonal regulation, tumor growth inhibition, and receptor pharmacology.
