Endothelin (16-21) is a 6-amino-acid A peptide from the endothelin family, one of the most potent vasoconstrictors known. Endothelins signal through ETA and ETB receptors to regulate vascular tone, cell proliferation, and fibrosis. Widely used in cardiovascular, pulmonary, and renal research for studying vasoconstriction, pulmonary hypertension, and the development of endothelin receptor antagonists.
