Biotin-Galanin, human is a 36-amino-acid A peptide from the galanin family, a neuropeptide widely expressed in the central and peripheral nervous systems. Galanin modulates neurotransmitter release (including acetylcholine, serotonin, and norepinephrine) through GalR1, GalR2, and GalR3 receptors, influencing cognition, pain, feeding, mood, and neuroendocrine function. Used in neuroscience research for studying neuropeptide signaling, Alzheimer's disease, epilepsy, and depression.
