PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Livagen is a tetrapeptide bioregulator for hepatic and lymphoid tissue. Nuclear penetration and DNA interaction induces heterochromatin decondensation, increasing transcriptional accessibility in hepatocytes. Restores metabolic activity in aged liver cells. Inhibits enkephalin-degrading enzymes (IC50 ? 20 µM).
